

Safety Protocol Overview for Parents: What to Expect at Camp Geneva in 2020

- **On Arrival:** There will be a camper health screening upon arrival at camp, which will include a temperature check with an infrared, non-touch thermometer. Parents will say goodbye to their campers at the vehicle and will need to remain in the parking lot. They will not be permitted to bring their child to the cabin. Camp Geneva staff will bring them to their cabin with their belongings.
- **Family Partnership:** Please let us know if you have any health concerns we should be aware of that may make your child more at risk for complications if they were to be exposed to COVID-19. If you or your camper has health concerns, please consult with the camper's physician regarding camp participation. Don't hesitate to contact us with any questions or other concerns.
- **Hand Sanitizing:** There will be sanitation stations throughout camp. Campers and staff will use hand sanitizer at regular intervals throughout the day.
- **Face Coverings:** The camp experience in 2020 will happen mainly outside, in small groups. However, each camper will be given a seamless bandana to wear when/if social distancing is not possible. Cabin groups will be considered a "family" and thus no face coverings will be necessary when it's only their group.
- **Daily Temperature Checks:** Each morning campers and staff will receive a temperature check with an infrared, non-touch thermometer.
- **Staff and Camper Training:** The staff will receive extra training on COVID-19, cleaning and sanitation, and new protocols for this summer. Campers will also receive additional guidance at the start of camp and each day for hand washing, sanitizing, etc.
- **Meals:** Meals will be prepared by food service and boxed, and campers will eat outside at picnic tables or near cabins. In the event of inclement weather, campers will eat in their cabin or on the cabin porch.
- **Songs/skits/worship:** These times in the schedule will happen on Camp Geneva's outdoor amphitheater in small groups that allow for social distancing.
- **Quarantine:** In the event a camper exhibits coronavirus symptoms or becomes sick, parents or guardians will be contacted and the camper will be removed from the cabin group and placed in the care of the health officers until a parent is able to pick them up.
- **Shared Items:** When at all possible, items will not be shared between campers and staff. In the event items need to be shared, they will be sanitized between campers.
- **Activities:** Much of the camp experience will be done in smaller groups including the pool, camp games, etc.
- **Sleeping at Camp Geneva** (if applicable): Campers will sleep head to toe so faces are at least six feet apart.
- **Opening/Closing Programs:** There will be no opening or closing program/ceremony. At the end of the camp week, staff will bring your camper(s) to your vehicle.
