Purposes of GENEVA Camp & Retreat Center

The purposes of GENEVA Camp & Retreat Center are to provide programming consistent our doctrinal foundation (*see below*) that promotes spiritual growth in the Christian faith, and to provide a setting in which individuals, churches, and organizations can retreat for reflection and renewal to better serve God and others.

Our Doctrinal Foundation

GENEVA Camp & Retreat Center was founded by members of the Reformed Church in America, a mainline Protestant denomination tracing its roots to the Reformation. In doctrinal perspective, Camp Geneva subscribes that of the historic Reformed position which understands the Old and New Testaments to be our only rules for faith and practice and sees the scriptures as inspired by God's Spirit and authoritative. The basics of the Reformed faith have historically been expressed in the "Standards of Unity": the Apostles' Creed, Nicene Creed, Athanasian Creed, Heidelberg Catechism, Belgic Confession, and Canons of Dort.

Our foundational affirmation is that we are a people who have been chosen by God to belong to God and to each other in Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, through our fellowship in the Holy Spirit. While Camp Geneva is Reformed in orientation, our approach in our camp weeks is to not teach doctrine, but to expose young people to the person of Jesus Christ, encourage them to grow in relationship with Him, and share Christ with others.
